But it will mean nothing to her, like it meant nothing in their past. Her heart is dead to him because it was Emerich she always wanted—in life and in death.



Whether she wants to or not.




Take this quiz to discover which *Dark Auras* character most closely matches your personality Choose the answer that best reflects how you'd respond in each situation.
